How the BCRM Fertility Counselling Service works

- Counselling can be accessed from the outset when you first come to the clinic and support continues for 6 months post treatment
- For NHS patients, BCRM is pleased to offer one complementary counselling appointment for each NHS funded IUI, or IVF/ICSI egg-collection cycle
- For self-funding patients, BCRM offers one complementary counselling appointment while you are having your investigations and tests and a further three complementary sessions for each IUI, or IVF/ICSI egg-collection cycle you may have



- Patients who are attending the Recurrent Miscarriage Clinic can have one complementary counselling appointment
- If you would like further emotional support, you are able to have as many counselling sessions as you need but these are provided on a self-funding basis
- You can come and see us in person in our dedicated Counselling Room at BCRM or, we can also speak by Zoom or telephone if preferred
- Appointments last one hour
- Counselling appointments can be accessed individually or with your partner (if you have one)
- The BCRM Fertility Counselling Service is confidential and is separate from your medical investigations, tests and treatments
- Please remember you do not need to be in a crisis to access the service

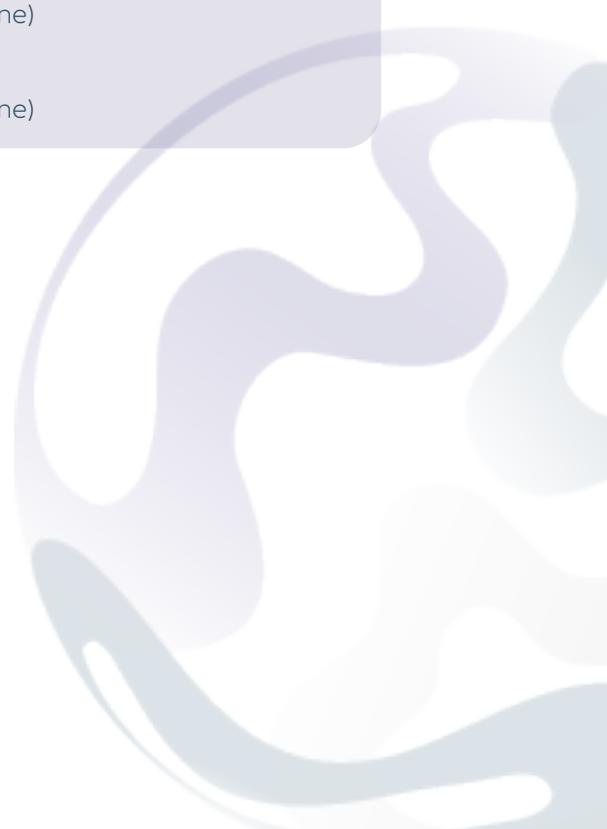
